WINTER AND THE WOOLLY MULLEIN

There's a bit of mountain folk lore that says that the winter's snow banks will reach the height of the plant called the woolly mullein. Of course, there is no reliable scientific evidence of this correlation, but it's still fun to think about! Tom Unruh, volunteer maintenance director, stands at 5'10" and just reaches the top of this plant.

Superstition aside, at least one long-term forecaster thinks there's some chance of a snowier winter than we've had in recent years. Dr. Klaus Wolter of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration told the Colorado Water Conservation Board that the snow forecast for much of Colorado is "fairly optimistic," though the El Nino/La Nina picture is neutral with a slight tendency toward a drier forecast for much of Colorado east of the Continental Divide. In other words, it's a tossup, with a slight till toward wet. Maybe the mullein knows!
