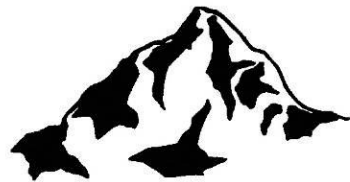

Make a reservation

- 1. SCHEDULE A DATE** – Contact the camp for available dates and facilities. Reservations are available at least three years in advance.
- 2. RENTAL AGREEMENT** – A rental agreement will be sent to the group contact stating the terms of the reservation one year prior to arrival date. For reservations scheduled more than one year in advance a confirmation will be sent with the dates and terms.
- 3. RENTAL DEPOSIT** – The deposit is due 30 days after receipt of the rental agreement. For Main Camp, Campground, and Park Ridge accommodations the deposit is 25% of the estimated total. For Emmental, Pleiades, Eagle's Nest, Sky-Hi-View, Rocky Ridge, and Solitude Center the deposit is 50%. No deposit is required for food service.
- 4. PRIOR TO ARRIVAL** – Inform the RMMC office of the number of guests attending and confirm food service and dietary needs **two weeks** prior to the arrival date. Also review the guidelines of RMMC and communicate them to all group members.
- 5. UPON ARRIVAL** (Check in after 4:00 pm) – Check in at the office before proceeding to your accommodations and pass along the following information: Correct number in group, any meal plan changes or corrections, method and time of payment, any AV equipment needs or other details.



6. DURING YOUR STAY – Comply faithfully with the camp policies and guidelines (ie: no pets please!) and assume all risk of personal injury and property loss or damage.

7. UPON DEPARTURE (Check out by 11:00 am) Check out at the office before departing to notify office of group's departure. Settle all financial arrangements and return facility keys.



Camp Guidelines

RMMC is a smoke free facility and environment.

Please DO NOT bring the following items to camp:

Discounts

Child Rate – age 3-11: ½ price; 2 & younger: FREE (applies only to per person fees)

Extended Stay – four nights and longer, 15% discount (lodging & meals)

Last Minute – within 2 weeks of stay, 15% discount

Off-Season – for stays between Sept. 16 and May 31 at Eagle's Nest - 15% off
for stays between Sept. 16 and May 31 at Sky-Hi-View - 30% off (no water)

Finance Policy

Deposits received will be applied toward payment of fees and are non-refundable unless notice of cancellation is given at least three months prior to reservation date AND if another guest group is found to rent the facility.

Cancellation of this agreement any time within three months prior to the reservation date requires payment of 80% of the total cost (guaranteed minimum is based on number of people and applies to Chalets, Rustic Cabins, and Park Ridge facilities only) unless another guest group is found to rent the facility.

Meal Cancellations – Guests will be financially responsible for meal cancellations within 24 hours of meal time.

Food Service

Food service is only available for groups of 12 or more people unless another guest group is already eating meals. All meals will be served June 1st through August 1st. Guests are required to utilize food service from camp unless staying in an accommodation with a kitchen or the campground, or eating away from camp. Two weeks advanced notice is requested for all meals and food service requests.

Dietary Considerations – Please contact camp two weeks in advance about our menu offerings or special dietary considerations.

Facility Kitchens – Facilities with a kitchen include: Emmental, Eagle's Nest, Rocky Ridge, Sky-Hi-View, Solitude Center, and Park Ridge. Plan to bring all cooking ingredients with you, including salt, pepper and condiments. Each cabin's kitchen inventory is listed at www.rmmc.org.

Details & Policies

Arrivals / Departures



Arrival time is 4:00 pm and departure time is 11:00 am.
You may request to extend your stay if no group is arriving in your facility at an additional fee of 10% per hour based on the facility cost.

Saturday Arrival/Departure – Groups arriving or departing on Saturday will be assessed an additional 50% of the facility charge for that day as it interrupts a typical weekend reservation (Friday-Sunday). Applies to reservations between June 1 and September 15.

Cabin Amenities

Amenities – Please bring personal toiletries for your stay as we do not provide soap, shampoo, etc. Sheets, towels, blankets, and pillows are provided in Emmental, Pleiades, Upper Aspen, Eagle's Nest, Rocky Ridge, Sky-Hi-View, and Solitude Center. For Chalets, Rustic Cabins, and Park Ridge, linens are not included and can be rented with advanced notice of your stay.

Cell Phones – Cell phone reception is limited at main camp. Ridge accommodations (Eagle's Nest, Rocky Ridge, and Sky-Hi-View) can get limited service based on the cell carrier. A phone is available in the office lobby for guest use.

Wi-Fi – A Wi-Fi signal is in various locations around camp. Because of camp's remote location and availability of high internet speeds, video or music streaming is not available.

Rocky Mountain Mennonite Camp is situated on the west side of the famous Pikes Peak about 30 miles west of Colorado Springs at 9,620 feet above sea level. The camp is completely surrounded by Pike National Forest. This affords a chance to experience Colorado's high country wilderness, with its clear streams, conifer and aspen forests, animals, birds, wildflowers, and the wonder of the world above timberline.
