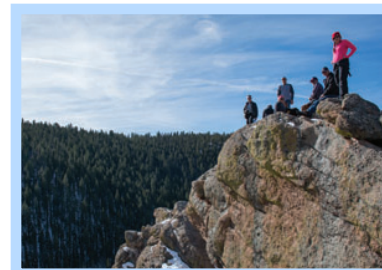

#### REGISTER:

NEW!! Online registration is now available! Follow the link to "Register Online" on [www.rmmc.org](http://www.rmmc.org). The registration page is set up for individuals to register, not for one person to register the entire group. Parents must register their children (not the youth sponsor), as the online forms include Medical History questions and the Medical Waiver. Any questions, please contact us!

**COST:** \$110 - Registration for youth & sponsors (\$115 for registrations received less than two weeks before session)

**DEPOSIT:** A \$50 non-refundable deposit is due for each youth and sponsor.

Registrations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis. Spaces can only be held with receipt of a deposit.

#### CANCELLATIONS:

Cancellations two weeks or prior to the camp session are refunded any amount above the non-refundable deposit. Cancellations within two weeks are not refunded unless another participant is found to take their spot.

#### SPONSORS:

Please provide one adult sponsor for every five youth and for each gender. If you have a small group or individual that needs a sponsor, contact the camp for help in connecting with another group as we want to make Snow Camp available to as many youth as possible.

#### WHAT TO BRING:

- Warm winter clothing (snow coat, pants & boots)
- Bedding/sleeping bag and pillow
- Towel and bathroom items
- Water bottle
- Bible
- Camera (optional)
- Spending money for the Trading Post (optional)

#### WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Electronic devices (video games, etc.)
- Cell phones (they don't work here anyway!)
- Fireworks, Firearms, Knives
- Alcohol, Tobacco, Marijuana
- Any illegal substances
- Pets
- Drones
